What is Probate?

Probate is the process of confirm your will. It includes a tax paid to the Ontario government on the value of your estate under the *Estate Administration Tax Act*. There is no tax on estates of \$50,000 or less. The estate tax is \$15/\$1,000 of value over \$50,000. The estate tax on a \$500,000 estate is \$6,750; on a \$1,000,000 estate, \$14,250.

Should I Avoid Probate?
